Background summary

Since 2001 user representatives from soundboard groups in the Networks Palliative Care are safeguarding the common interests of people in the palliative stage. User participation in the Networks Palliative Care is applied very practical, through the participation of user representatives in the soundboard groups. There are six in Limburg (NL), one soundboard group for each Network Palliative Care. Huis voor de Zorg Limburg supports the NPC's and their soundboard groups.
